Organics Recycling Program Composting Guidelines

Organics Collection

Always De-Package Organics before recycling
(Remove all plastic, metal, glass and Styrofoam)

The following materials are compostable (biodegradable):

- Fruit & Vegetable Cull & Trim
- Outdated & Spoiled Food Products
- Salads, Salad Bar items, Salad materials
- Paper Towels, Paper & Waxed Paper
- Waxed & Wet Cardboard
- Wood Boxes, Crates, Pieces – No treated wood – No nails
- Bread & Bakery Products
- Meat, Poultry, Seafood and Bones
- All Paper Plates, Cups & Bowls

Place all ORGANIC materials in designated ORGANIC containers.

Unacceptable Material

The following items are unacceptable:

- Plastic, Plastic Cases
- Oyster shells
- Oils or Grease
- Price Tags & Strips
- Styrofoam
- Metal, Aluminum Foil & Aluminum Twist Ties
- Glass
- Cans
- Fabric Tape, Rope, Twine,
- Rubber Bands, Band-Aids
- Gloves

Place all unacceptable materials in single-stream bin or landfill bin.
